## Primary Dutch Bilingual

Dear parents/ guardians,

We have been working hard on the after school activities program for the new school year, and we are happy to share our program for the first cycle with you. We have added boxing to the program this cycle (the judo instructor is unfortunately no longer available, but hopefully boxing is a nice alternative for our students).

On the next pages you can find the schedule for and a description of the After School Activities for the first cycle, which runs from **Monday September 22 to Friday January 30** (catch up lessons in the last two weeks before the Carnival Break). On study days there will be no activities.

On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, students go straight to their activity after school. They may bring a snack to eat at the start of the activity. On Wednesday we will organize lunch supervision for all students who are going to after school activities. The children can bring a packed lunch then. Children who go to BSO on Wednesdays, will have lunch at the BSO before going to their activity. These students don't need to bring a packed lunch.

If your child goes to the BSO, please inform the BSO of your child's after school activities. We expect you to pick up your child on time after the activity. At the end of the activity, you are responsible for the safety of your child. Children who go to BSO will be brought to the BSO after the activity.

Make sure you check the age groups the activity is for, so you sign your child up for the right activities. Please note: once you have signed up your child for an activity, it is not possible to cancel the activity anymore for this cycle.

For parents who also wish to sign up their children for home language classes: you will receive this information separately from our home languages coordinator (Elise van Holst). Make sure you don't sign up your child for other after school activities on the same day as the home language class. The home languages classes will take place on the following days & times: **Turkish** (Monday 15:30 – 16:45), **Spanish** 

(Tuesday 15:30 – 16:30), **Greek** (Wednesday 13:00 – 14:00), **Mandarin** (Friday 15:30 – 16:30), **Portuguese** (day to be determined with the parents who are interested). Maybe other languages will be offered as well. Several home language teachers are also available for lessons at our location, depending on demand. You will receive this information from the home languages coordinator, and you can let her know if you are interested in these lessons for your child(ren).
